



GO SLOW. Go as slow as safely possible in areas bounded by red lines—the voluntary Sea Turtle Protection Zone—and limit your travel time in these areas. Follow any posted speed-zone signs—it's required by law.

WEAR POLARIZED SUNGLASSES to see and avoid sea turtles in your path, and ask one of your passengers to be the **DESIGNATED WILDLIFE SPOTTER.**
